### ALBERT M. NICHTER (1898-1988)

Professor Nichter's work emphasized social security for farmers, inheritance and transfer of property, accounting, custom rates, and income tax management. He gained a wide spread reputation on income tax management, which he has continued to maintain since his retirement in 1961. "Nick" joined the Purdue staff in 1935 as a County Agricultural Agent, moving to the campus in 1940 where he served on the County Agent Leader's staff as a Land Use Planner, rising to State Supervisor of the Emergency Farm Labor Office in 1946. In 1948, he joined the Agricultural Economics Department in Farm Management Extension. He served for a number of years as Secretary-Treasurer of the Indiana Farm Management Association, and continued an active association with his church and community. B.S.A. - Purdue, 1920.
