REQUIREMENTS

1. Language credit must be established through the fourth course, and one conversation course, if offered. The language selected should relate to the country/region in which the student will spend time abroad, If that language is not taught at Purdue, or if the student focuses on an English-speaking country/region, then another language may be substituted.
2. Fifteen or more credits with an international focus. At least six credits must focus upon the selected country/region. In most cases additional language credits cannot be used. At least six credits should be completed outside of the College of Agriculture.
3. A minimum of eight-weeks (in one time period) must be spent abroad in a pre-approved study abroad, cooperative work experience, internship, or cultural exchange.
4. A summary paper and oral presentation must be completed and evaluated no later than 30 days after the conclusion of the student's final academic term.
